Beijing University of Technology

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About BJUT

Beijing University of Technology (BJUT) was established in 1960, in the southeast industrial area of Beijing. It is a high-level multi-disciplinary research university providing programs in science, engineering, economics, management, literature, law, art and education, with engineering as a core focus.

In 1981, BJUT was approved as one of the first universities in China to confer Master's Degrees. In 1985, BJUT was approved to confer Doctoral Degrees. In 1996, BJUT entered the list of key universities in the national "211 Project". In 2017, BJUT officially entered the list of universities in the national "Double First-Class" Initiative. In 2022, 11 disciplines including Engineering, Materials Sciences, Chemistry, Environment & Ecology, Computer Science, Biology & Biochemistry, General Social Sciences, Physics, Geosciences, Clinical Medicine and Mathematics entered Top 1% of the ESI Rankings, among which Engineering ranked Top 1‰.



Located at 100 Pingleyuan, Chaoyang District, Beijing, BJUT is adjacent to South East Fourth Ring Road in the east, West Dawang Road in the west, Shuanglong Road in the south, and Pingleyuan Community in the north; the university has 6 extension campuses in Zhonglan Community, Guanzhuang Town, Huayuancun Community, Liulijing Community, Huixin East Street, and Tongzhou District; in total, BJUT covers an area of 961,418 square meters.

01 Curriculum

The undergraduate program curriculum consists of general obligatory courses, academic obligatory courses, academic elective courses, practical training obligatory courses, practical training elective courses, elective practice training, general education elective courses and courses on Chinese culture, economy, society, laws, history and philosophy, etc.

General obligatory courses include An Overview on China, Chinese for Science & Technology, Comprehensive Chinese, Mathematics, Physics, Probability and Statistics, Linear Algebra and Physical Education. Academic obligatory courses, academic elective courses, practical training obligatory courses and practical training elective courses and general education courses are carried out in accordance with specific academic curriculums.

02 Eligibility

1. Applicants must be non-Chinese citizens with a valid passport, between the ages of 18 and 25 (starting from September 1, 2007), in good physical and mental health, and have attained a senior high school diploma.

2. Applicants should meet the conditions set by the Document No. 12 (2020) of Ministry of Education of the PRC.

3. Language requirement: new HSK-4 or above level. Applicants whose compulsory courses were taught in Chinese during secondary education (junior and senior high school) can be exempt from submitting HSK certificate

4. Applicants should take part in interview and entrance examination. Interview will be conducted online and applicants will be informed about detailed information after passing our preliminary review. Entrance examination will include the following subjects:

- For Chinese language related programs, applicants should take test on Chinese language;
- For Economics, Science & Engineering programs, applicants should take exams on Chinese, Mathematics, or Physics/Chemistry (depending on targeted bachelor program).

01 Admission Requirements

1.Applicants must be non-Chinese citizens with a valid passport and in good physical and mental health;

2. Age, Degree, and language requirements:

- To apply for master programs, applicants should be over 18 and under 35 years old, holding a bachelor or above degree; to apply for doctoral program, applicants should be under 40 years old and holding a master or above degree;
- To apply for programs taught in Chinese, applicants should hold a HSK 4 or above lever certificate or have completed their high school diploma or above degree in Chinese.

※ Note: Applicants who do not meet the admission requirements of the Chinese language are entitled to one-year preparatory courses in BJUT.

- To apply for programs taught in English, applicants should meet one of the following language requirements:
 - TOEFL 85+;
 - IELTS 6.5+
 - TOEIC 750+;
 - Duolingo English Test 110+;
 - The instruction language is English in senior high school or above study period.

01 Eligibility

1. Applicants must be non-Chinese citizens with a valid passport and in good physical and mental health.

2.Applicants should be over 18 and under 24 years old;

3.Degree or diploma: the applicant shall provide a high school diploma or above;

There is no entrance requirement for Chinese language level for Level I; Applicants for Level II shall have passed HSK 3 180 or above, otherwise they need to take entrance exam.

5.The applicant must have sufficient financial capability for studying and living in China.

Campus Life



01 Library

The Library of BJUT covers an area of 40,000 plus square meters, equipped with over 3,000 seats; the library in Tongzhou Campus has an area of more than 2,000 square meters, equipped with over 500 seats. The library comprises over two million Chinese and foreign paper books and over 1,600 Chinese and foreign periodicals and magazines, coupled with massive electronic resources. In the open service, students can collect, borrow and read various books. It is open 105 hours a week.

02 Hospital

Located on the northeast campus, the hospital can diagnose and treat common chronic diseases for students. The hospital offers 24-hour emergency services to respond to students' emergencies on campus.

03 Canteen

The campus comprises ten canteens that serve you high-quality foods every day. Each canteen provides a wide range of dishes in a spacious, bright, clean, comfortable, and distinctive dining environment. There are also western-style restaurants and Halal restaurants on campus to cater to the different dietary needs of international students.

04 International Student Dormitory

The Beijing University of Technology International Student Apartments provide accommodation services for international students on campus, with over 200 dormitories and multiple types of accommodation available, accommodating nearly 400 international students at the same time. The dormitory is equipped with wired and wireless networks, air conditioning, and simple furniture. The international student dormitory also has public facilities such as study rooms, kitchens, and self-service laundry rooms.

05 Student Art Ensemble

The Student Art Ensemble of BJUT is composed of a choir, dance troupe, symphony orchestra, drama troupe, concert band, and Chinese orchestra. All kinds of art groups, popular among students, are flourishing. They have held a number of art shows and special performances and participated in various national and municipal art competitions, all with good results.
